# A Meeting was called to order on . . .

June 13, 2018 at the Field at 7pm. We had 10 members in attendance. The Treasurer reported \$1,401.47 in checking and \$6,000+/- in savings (we only get statements every quarter).

Plans for IMAC were reviewed and it was determined that we needed someone to help both days cooking. Volunteer hands were noted.

The Solar Project update was reviewed, and members were presented with a scale field plan drawing to take with them if anybody had ideas about a new field location. Our current landlord has found a site on Baker Road which is about 3 miles from the current field and which could be secured once the corn has been cut. Several Officers have visited the field, measured with the owner and flags placed in the likely location of the corners. A building permit would need to be sought to move our existing trailers and pole structures and the owner would help secure that as well as help level the field and seed in the fall. So all that is left to do is review our options in 30-60 days and start growing some new grass. Some members have asked "What is the big rush?" The answer from my perspective is the need to grow grass, and the best planting time is September. We might get another year at the old field, or might be faced with flying over construction, might lose our driveway, might have materials or fencing at the end of the runway. With the need to plan annual IMAC and Jim Coll sanctioned events- we really need a location we can count on and giving these events up for a year when we most need the funds doesn't seem like a good plan. So while the club has room for differing opinions, planning to move is something we need to work through and pick a plan soon.

There being no further business, and members wanting to get away from the bugs, the meeting was adjourned at 7:49 pm
